

### **MainStreet Alexander City**

MainStreet Alexander City's mission is to enhance, preserve, and promote the downtown historical district. The National Trust began the National MainStreet Program for Historic Preservation.

MainStreet Alexander City through its working committees and Board of Directors have seen great improvement yearly in our downtown commercial district since its origin in 1994. Much has been accomplished this year in downtown and within our organization.

- Contracted with Bette Anderson to plant seasonal flowers in the Broad Street Plaza, beds on Main Street, Calhoun Street, Broad Street and the Roundabout.
- Drafted and presented to the City of Alexander City a Preservation Ordinance to protect our historical district which the passed by resolution thus creating a Preservation Commission and Guidelines for future protection of our historical structures.
- Worked with WSFA in placing a weather camera in downtown which features Alexander City on Channel 12 twelve to fifteen times weekly.
- Design Alabama (an architectural magazine) selected downtown Alexander City for a feature visit for their on-line magazine.
- Continue to promote Alexander City through our updated website (mainstreetalexandercity.org) and our new Facebook page.
- Working with the city in improving the landscaping and appearance of the Bud Porch Center.
- Our strong relationship with WSFA has brought them to Alexander City to do feature stories on downtown, The Shoppes of Queen's Attic, Robinson Iron, John Neighbors Farm, and the Jazz Fest.
